WASHINGTON, Jan. 12.—George L. Lorillard, American diplomatic representative at the temporary Serbian capital at Corfu, Greece, has resigned. Mr. Lorillard before being sent to Corfu was on detail without being accredited to any Government. Mr. Lorillard is a native of Newport, a Harvard graduate, and entered the diplomatic service in 1903 as second secretary at the legation at Havana.
